The EYBA is a European non-profit association founded in 1993, in Prague. Since 2018, the EYBA has a participatory status at the Conference of INGOs of the Council of Europe and since 2021 it is admitted to the EU Transparency Register.

## **Cooperation within Council of Europe Projects**

#### **HELP Course on Ethics for Lawyers**

The EYBA jointly with European Association of Lawyers (AEA-EAL) partnered with Council of Europe on implementation of the HELP course on Ethics for Lawyers. More than 40 participants from 12 countries across Europe and Central Asia registered for the training. Vladimir Palamarciuc, the President of the EYBA served as co-tutor for this cross-border training, being also co-author of the module on Ethics for Lawyers of this HELP course.

#### **Regional Project on Strengthening Cooperation between Young Lawyers**

The EYBA and EYBA's members cooperated with CoE since 2019 within the Regional Project on Strengthening Cooperation between Lawyers. As the result of this cooperation the EYBA Regional Committee for Cooperation in Eastern Europe was established with the aim to strengthen the regional cooperation for the young lawyers and their associations from the Eastern European countries and enhance their integration into the community of European legal professionals. The Regional Committee includes EYBA members representatives from Armenia, Georgia, Republic of Moldova and Ukraine. Since its creation the Regional Committee organizes seminars and professional discussions and improve the contact with colleagues western European jurisdictions.

The EYBA, following the resolution on **Empowering European Youth** in the context of the European Year of Youth and our society postcovid, has launched a survey among its members in order to:

The EYBA, as partner of ERA academy submitted a project in response to the European Commission's call for proposals on judicial training for young lawyers in the area of EU law. The application was successful. The EYBA will cover the expenses for the participation of 4 candidates to the Course, selected through a public call for applications.



## **Ongoing Projects**

#### Survey on unpaid legal traineeships

• collect the national rules (laws or code of conducts) regarding legal traineeship (focused on the remuneration) specifying if those rules are mandatory or not, and if there is any remedy for a young legal trainee with respect to violation of the rules;

• evaluate if those rules are respected in practice (whether or not they are mandatory) or if there is still a phenomenon of "exploitative practices".
